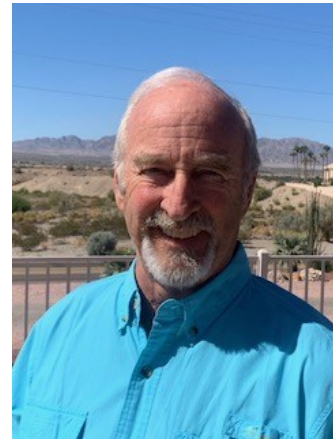
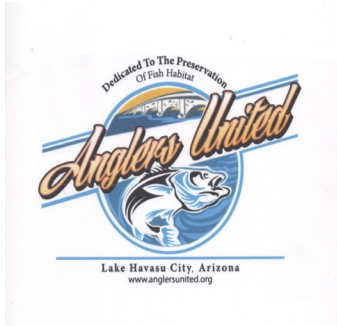


Anglers United Newsletter
